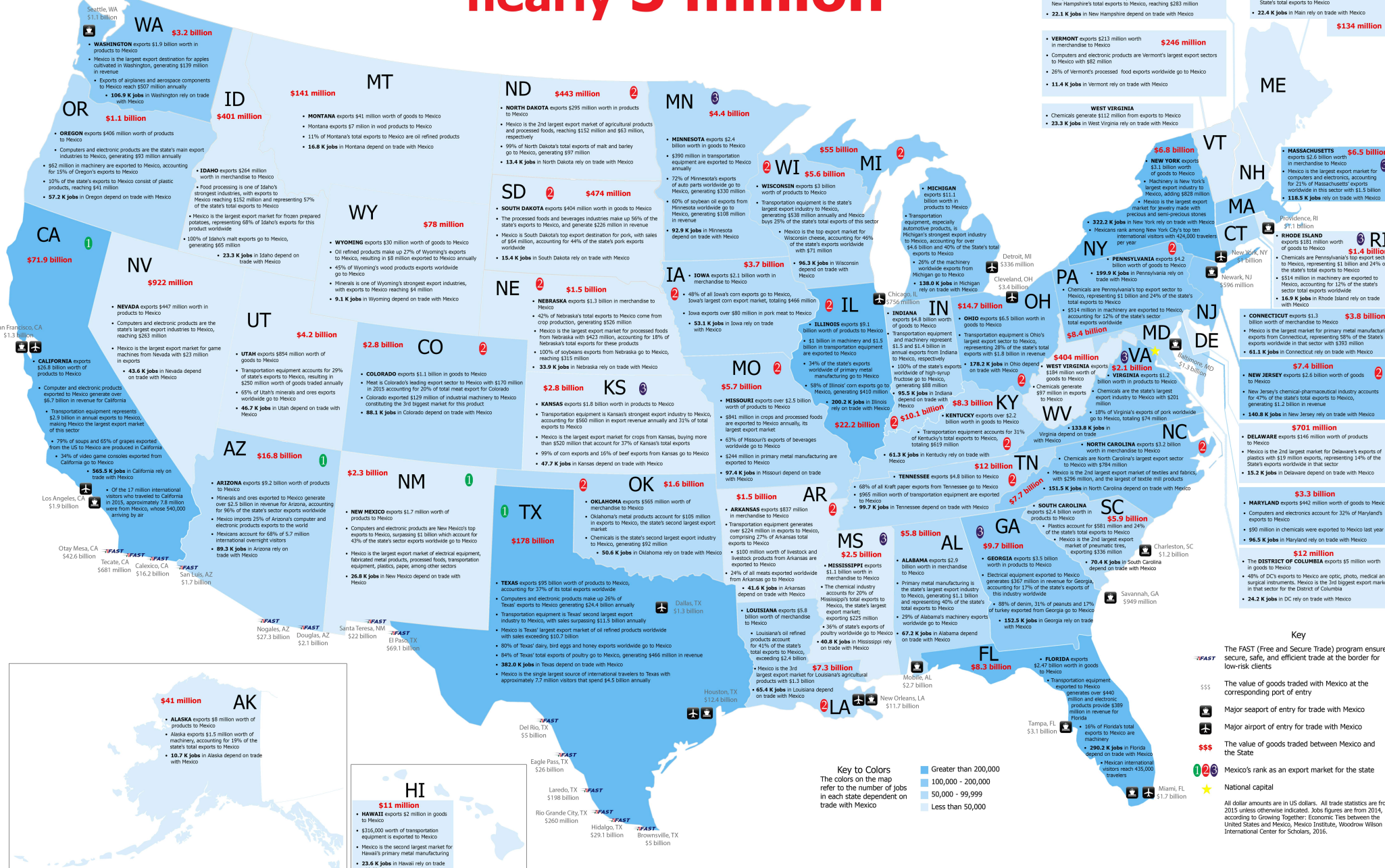


# U.S. jobs depend on trade with Mexico nearly 5 million



**NEW HAMPSHIRE** exports \$83 million worth in goods to Mexico **\$977 million** 2

- Computers and other electronic products account for 56% of New Hampshire's total exports to Mexico, reaching \$283 million
- 22.1 K jobs** in New Hampshire depend on trade with Mexico

**MAINE** exports \$66 million worth of products to Mexico **\$134 million**

- Faper is Maine's top export sector to Mexico with \$18 million, accounting for 30% of the State's total exports to Mexico
- 22.4 K jobs** in Maine rely on trade with Mexico

**VERMONT** exports \$213 million worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$246 million**

- Computers and electronic products are Vermont's largest export sectors to Mexico with \$82 million
- 26% of Vermont's processed food exports worldwide go to Mexico
- 11.4 K jobs** in Vermont rely on trade with Mexico

**WEST VIRGINIA**

- Chemicals generate \$112 million from exports to Mexico
- 23.3 K jobs** in West Virginia rely on trade with Mexico

**MASSACHUSETTS** exports \$2.6 billion worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$6.5 billion** 3

- Mexico is the largest export market for computers and electronics, accounting for 21% of Massachusetts' exports worldwide in this sector with \$1.5 billion
- 118.5 K jobs** rely on trade with Mexico

**RHODE ISLAND** exports \$181 million worth of goods to Mexico **\$1.4 billion** 6

- Chemicals are Pennsylvania's top export sector to Mexico, representing \$1 billion and 24% of the state's total exports to Mexico
- \$514 million in machinery are exported to Mexico, accounting for 12% of the state's sector total exports worldwide
- 16.9 K jobs** in Rhode Island rely on trade with Mexico

**NEW YORK** exports \$3.1 billion worth of goods to Mexico **\$11.1 billion** 2

- Machinery is New York's largest export industry to Mexico, adding \$828 million
- Mexico is the largest export market for jewelry made with precious or semi-precious stones per year
- 322.2 K jobs** in New York rely on trade with Mexico

**PENNSYLVANIA** exports \$4.2 billion worth of goods to Mexico **\$14.7 billion** 2

- Mechanics rank among New York City's top ten international visitors with 424,000 travelers per year
- Chemicals are Pennsylvania's top export sector to Mexico, representing \$1 billion and 24% of the state's total exports to Mexico
- \$514 million in machinery are exported to Mexico, accounting for 12% of the state's sector total exports worldwide
- 16.9 K jobs** in Rhode Island rely on trade with Mexico

**CONNECTICUT** exports \$1.3 billion worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$3.8 billion**

- Mexico is the largest market for primary metal manufacturing exports from Connecticut, representing 58% of the State's exports worldwide in that sector with \$293 million
- 61.1 K jobs** in Connecticut rely on trade with Mexico

**NEW JERSEY** exports \$7.4 billion worth of goods to Mexico **\$21.6 billion** 2

- New Jersey's chemical-pharmaceutical industry accounts for 47% of the state's total exports to Mexico, generating \$14.2 billion in revenue
- 140.8 K jobs** in New Jersey rely on trade with Mexico

**DELAWARE** exports \$146 million worth of products to Mexico **\$701 million**

- Mexico is the 2nd largest market for Delaware's exports with \$10 million exports, representing 14% of the state's exports worldwide in that sector
- 15.2 K jobs** in Delaware depend on trade with Mexico

**MARYLAND** exports \$442 million worth of goods to Mexico **\$3.3 billion**

- Computers and electronics account for 32% of Maryland's exports to Mexico
- \$90 million in chemicals were exported to Mexico last year
- 96.5 K jobs** in Maryland rely on trade with Mexico

**WEST VIRGINIA** exports \$2.1 billion worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$1.1 billion**

- Chemicals generate \$97 million in exports to Mexico
- 18% of Virginia's exports of pork worldwide go to Mexico, totaling \$74 million
- 132.8 K jobs** in Virginia depend on trade with Mexico

**NORTH CAROLINA** exports \$3.2 billion worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$7.1 billion** 2

- Chemicals are North Carolina's largest export sector to Mexico with \$784 million
- Mexico is the 2nd largest export market for textiles and fabrics, with \$296 million, and the largest of textile mill products
- 151.5 K jobs** in North Carolina depend on trade with Mexico

**SOUTH CAROLINA** exports \$2.4 billion worth in products to Mexico **\$5.9 billion**

- Plastics account for \$581 million and 24% of the state's total exports to Mexico
- Mexico is the 2nd largest export market of pneumatic tires, exporting \$336 million
- 70.4 K jobs** in South Carolina depend on trade with Mexico

**THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA** exports \$5 million worth in goods to Mexico **\$12 million**

- 48% of DC's exports to Mexico are optic, photo, medical and surgical instruments. Mexico is the 3rd largest export market in that sector for the District of Columbia
- 24.2 K jobs** in DC rely on trade with Mexico

**ALABAMA** exports \$2.9 billion worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$5.8 billion** 6

- Primary metal manufacturing is the state's largest export industry to Mexico, generating \$1.1 billion and representing 40% of the state's total exports to Mexico
- 29% of Alabama's machinery exports worldwide go to Mexico
- 88% of denim, 31% of peanuts and 17% of turkey exported from Georgia go to Mexico
- 152.5 K jobs** in Alabama depend on trade with Mexico

**MISSISSIPPI** exports \$1.1 billion worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$2.5 billion** 6

- The chemical industry accounts for 20% of Mississippi's total exports to Mexico, the state's largest export market, accounting for \$225 million
- 36% of state's exports of poultry worldwide go to Mexico
- Louisiana's oil refined products account for 41% of the state's total exports to Mexico, exceeding \$2.4 billion
- Mexico is the 3rd largest export market for Louisiana's agricultural products with \$1.3 billion
- 65.4 K jobs** in Louisiana depend on trade with Mexico

**FLORIDA** exports \$2.4 billion worth in goods to Mexico **\$8.3 billion**

- Transportation equipment generates over \$440 million and electronic products provide \$399 million in revenue for Florida
- 15% of Florida's total exports to Mexico are machinery
- 290.2 K jobs** in Florida depend on trade with Mexico
- Mexican international visitors reach 435,000 travelers

- 24% of all meats exported worldwide from Arkansas go to Mexico

- Louisiana's oil refined products account for 41% of the state's total exports to Mexico, exceeding \$2.4 billion

- Exports of airplanes and aerospace components to Mexico reach \$507 million annually
- 106.9 K jobs** in Washington rely on trade with Mexico

**OREGON** exports \$406 million worth of products to Mexico **\$1.1 billion**

- Computers and electronic products are the state's main export industries to Mexico, generating \$93 million annually
- \$62 million in machinery are exported to Mexico, accounting for 15% of Oregon's exports to Mexico
- 50% of the state's exports to Mexico consist of plastic products, reaching \$41 million
- 57.2 K jobs** in Oregon depend on trade with Mexico

**MONTANA** exports \$41 million worth of goods to Mexico **\$141 million**

- Montana exports \$7 million in wood products to Mexico
- 11% of Montana's total exports to Mexico are oil refined products
- 16.8 K jobs** in Montana depend on trade with Mexico

**MINNESOTA** exports \$2.4 billion worth of goods to Mexico **\$4.4 billion** 6

- \$399 million in transportation equipment are exported to Mexico annually
- 72% of Minnesota's exports of auto parts worldwide go to Mexico, generating \$370 million
- 60% of soybean oil exports from Minnesota worldwide go to Mexico
- Mexico is the top export market for Wisconsin cheese, accounting for 46% of the state's exports worldwide with \$71 million
- 92.9 K jobs** in Minnesota depend on trade with Mexico

**IDAHO** exports \$264 million worth in merchandise to Mexico **\$401 million**

- Food processing is one of Idaho's strongest industries, with exports to Mexico reaching \$152 million and representing 57% of the state's total exports to Mexico
- Mexico is the largest export market for frozen prepared potatoes, representing 68% of Idaho's exports for this product worldwide
- 100% of Idaho's meat exports go to Mexico, generating \$65 million
- 23.3 K jobs** in Idaho depend on trade with Mexico

**WYOMING** exports \$30 million worth of goods to Mexico **\$78 million**

- Oil refined products make up 27% of Wyoming's exports to Mexico, resulting in \$8 million exported to Mexico annually
- 45% of Wyoming's wood products exports worldwide go to Mexico
- Mining is one of Wyoming's strongest export industries, with exports to Mexico reaching \$4 million

**SOUTH DAKOTA** exports \$404 million worth in goods to Mexico **\$474 million** 2

- The processed foods and beverages industries make up 56% of the state's exports to Mexico, and generate \$236 million in revenue
- Mexico is South Dakota's top export destination for pork, with sales of \$64 million, accounting for 44% of the state's pork exports worldwide
- 15.4 K jobs** in South Dakota rely on trade with Mexico

**NEBRASKA** exports \$1.3 billion in merchandise to Mexico **\$1.5 billion**

- 42% of Nebraska's total exports to Mexico come from crop production, generating \$256 million
- Mexico is the largest export market for processed foods from Nebraska with \$425 million, accounting for 18% of Nebraska's total exports for these products
- 100% of soybeans exports from Nebraska go to Mexico, reaching \$315 million
- 33.9 K jobs** in Nebraska rely on trade with Mexico

**UTAH** exports \$854 million worth of goods to Mexico **\$4.2 billion**

- Transportation equipment accounts for 29% of Utah's exports to Mexico, resulting in \$250 million worth of goods traded annually
- 65% of Utah's minerals and ores exports worldwide go to Mexico

**NEVADA** exports \$447 million worth in products to Mexico **\$922 million**

- Computers and electronic products are the state's largest export industries to Mexico, reaching \$263 million
- Mexico is the largest export market for game machines from Nevada with \$23 million in exports
- 43.6 K jobs** in Nevada depend on trade with Mexico

**CALIFORNIA** exports \$26.8 billion worth of products to Mexico **\$71.9 billion** 1

- Computer and electronic products exported to Mexico generate over \$6.7 billion in revenue for California
- Transportation equipment represents \$2.9 billion in annual exports to Mexico, making Mexico the largest export market of this sector
- 79% of soups and 65% of grapes exported from the US to Mexico are produced in California
- 34% of video game consoles exported from California go to Mexico
- 665.3 K jobs** in California rely on trade with Mexico

**ARIZONA** exports \$9.2 billion worth of products to Mexico **\$16.8 billion** 1

- Of the 17 million international visitors who traveled to California in 2015, approximately 7.8 million were from Mexico, while \$40,000 arriving by air
- Minerals and ores exported to Mexico generate over \$2.5 billion in revenue for Arizona, accounting for 96% of the state's sector exports worldwide
- Mechanics account for 68% of 5.7 million international overnight visitors
- 89.3 K jobs** in Arizona rely on trade with Mexico

**UTAH** exports \$854 million worth of goods to Mexico **\$4.2 billion**

- Transportation equipment accounts for 29% of Utah's exports to Mexico, resulting in \$250 million worth of goods traded annually
- 65% of Utah's minerals and ores exports worldwide go to Mexico
- 46.7 K jobs** in Utah depend on trade with Mexico

**NEVADA** exports \$447 million worth in products to Mexico **\$922 million**

- Computers and electronic products are the state's largest export industries to Mexico, reaching \$263 million
- Mexico is the largest export market for game machines from Nevada with \$23 million in exports

**CALIFORNIA** exports \$26.8 billion worth of products to Mexico **\$71.9 billion** 1

- Computer and electronic products exported to Mexico generate over \$6.7 billion in revenue for California
- Transportation equipment represents \$2.9 billion in annual exports to Mexico, making Mexico the largest export market of this sector
- 79% of soups and 65% of grapes exported from the US to Mexico are produced in California
- 34% of video game consoles exported from California go to Mexico
- 665.3 K jobs** in California rely on trade with Mexico

**ARIZONA** exports \$9.2 billion worth of products to Mexico **\$16.8 billion** 1

- Of the 17 million international visitors who traveled to California in 2015, approximately 7.8 million were from Mexico, while \$40,000 arriving by air
- Minerals and ores exported to Mexico generate over \$2.5 billion in revenue for Arizona, accounting for 96% of the state's sector exports worldwide
- Mechanics account for 68% of 5.7 million international overnight visitors
- 89.3 K jobs** in Arizona rely on trade with Mexico

**NEW MEXICO** exports \$1.7 million worth of products to Mexico **\$2.3 billion** 1

- Computers and electronic products are New Mexico's top exports to Mexico, surpassing \$1 billion which accounts for 43% of the state's sector exports worldwide go to Mexico
- Mexico is the largest export market of electrical equipment, fabricated metal products, processed foods, transportation equipment, plastics, paper, among other sectors
- 26.8 K jobs** in New Mexico depend on trade with Mexico

**OKLAHOMA** exports \$565 million worth of merchandise to Mexico **\$1.6 billion** 2

- Oklahoma's metal products account for \$109 million in exports to Mexico, the state's second largest export market
- Chemicals is the state's second largest export industry to Mexico, generating \$92 million
- 50.6 K jobs** in Oklahoma rely on trade with Mexico

**TEXAS** exports \$95 billion worth of products to Mexico, accounting for 37% of its total exports worldwide **\$178 billion** 2

- Computers and electronic products make up 26% of Texas' exports to Mexico generating \$24.1 billion annually
- Transportation equipment is Texas' second largest export industry to Mexico, with sales surpassing \$11.5 billion annually
- Mexico is Texas' largest export market of oil refined products worldwide with sales exceeding \$10.7 billion
- 80% of Texas' dairy, bird eggs and honey exports worldwide go to Mexico
- 84% of Texas' total exports of poultry go to Mexico, generating \$466 million in revenue
- 382.8 K jobs** in Texas depend on trade with Mexico
- Mexico is the single largest source of international travelers to Texas with approximately 7.7 million visitors that spend \$4.5 billion annually
