


# <u>New COVID-19</u> Cases and Deaths per 1 Million People


## Percentage of Vaccines Administered

Shows the percentage of vaccines at distribution sites that have been administered




Administered Vaccines (63.81%) exican statistics are updated as of 4/6/21, with data resenting the number of vaccines administered of the total that have arrived in country.

### <u>Vaccine Doses per 100 People</u>




The average dose administration in each region per 100 people

## Stage 1

Residents and staff of elderly care facilities, adults over 70, healthcare workers with direct contact with patients, and adults living in indigenous communities

### Stage 2

Residents of all group-living facilities, all healthcare workers, adults over 60, all adul<u>ts from</u> indigenous communities, ad<u>ults</u> from marginalized frontline essential workers

#### Stage 3

#### People with underlying medical conditions, adults over 50, and non-frontline essential workers
